The college research journal with ISSN number 2277-4246 which is peer-reviewed and multidisciplinary in nature, was published timely under the strict supervision of IQAC.

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


Under the guidance and monitoring of IQAC, the college has organized one international seminar and eight national seminars.





An induction training programme for faculty members was convened on 1 June to introduce new faculty members, brief on the main targets for the year, make the staff aware of their administrative responsibilities, and the code of conduct to be followed. Furthermore, the principal presented the academic calendar and explained the duties of various positions. IQAC, along with the Research Advisory Committee, met with staff members in person and motivated them to apply for research projects and seminars. An action plan for the college for the entire academic year was prepared and distributed to departments, forums, and clubs so that they could plan different programs early at the beginning of the academic year. IQAC invited input from all departments, clubs, and forums to help realize the action plan.



The admission committee supervised a smooth and transparent admission process for undergraduate programs. In collaboration with the admission committee, the IQAC organized a one-day induction program for first-year undergraduate and postgraduate students to familiarize them with the rules, regulations, functioning culture, and best practices of the college. With the help of the admission committee, IQAC updated the guidelines for preparing the college prospectus. Students were selected from first-year batches for various Student Support Programmes.

Remedial classes have been started for academically weak students.

An institutional SWOC analysis was conducted in separate sessions for faculty, students and non-teaching staff.

IQAC organized an External audit on for the year 2018-19. An academic audit team consists of Dr. H. K. Santhosh, Dr. Kaladharan and Dr. Rasheed of SNGS college, Pattambi.

Placement proposals were received from teachers and submitted to the Directorate of collegiate education. A two-day CAS training program was conducted for teachers to familiarize them with the rules of the Career Advancement Scheme. The programme was inaugurated on 12.07.2019 in the college seminar hall at 3.30 pm.



IQAC monitored curricular transactions regularly and monitored the quality of education. Internal exams are conducted in a centralized manner. Remedial classes were conducted for the academically weaker students. PTA meetings for all undergraduate classes were conducted successfully The teacher's diary is prepared, distributed to teachers, and monitored regularly. Conducted separate SWOC analysis among students, teachers, and non-teaching staff. The teaching plans of the course teachers were collected.

IQAC and thee college council continuously upholds the best practices of the college. The students and staff of Government Arts & Science College Calicut under 'GASC relief cell' worked tirelessly during the floods that affected Kerala in 2018, to support the welfare of society. The college served as a flood relief center during those days. Students and teachers contributed by collecting and distributing materials to those in need. The college provided food, clothing, medical, and sanitation facilities to the affected persons. Additionally, the college engaged in the rehabilitation of villages by participating in the cleaning of houses and premises in the affermath. The college also made contributions to the Chief Minister's Distress Relief Fund (CMDRF) and directly assisted needy individuals.


